Academic Exchange with the Max Planck Law

You are invited to apply to the academic exchange programme between the Institute of European and Comparative Law, on behalf of the Law Faculty, and a network of nine legal research institutes of the Max Planck Society. The exchange is open to Faculty members and graduate research students of the Oxford Law Faculty who wish to pursue research at the Max Planck Institute. Under the agreement, Oxford may send to Germany two eligible persons (academic staff or research students) for a visit of up to two months between March and September.

The Max Planck Institute will endeavour to make accommodation available, a dedicated workspace with a computer will be available, and generous library access. There will be no teaching or other formal obligations, although visitors might be asked to give a paper on their ongoing research. Visitors will be considered for a stipend of EUR 1,400 per month. Knowledge of the German language is an asset but is not required in the working environment of the Institute.

Faculty members and graduate research students who wish to go to Germany during the **academic year 2024-25** (i.e. **between 1 March and 30 September 2025**) should submit their application via this [Form](#) by 12 noon Friday of Week 0 of Hilary term (**17 January 2025**). Applications should include the completed application form, a (short) statement setting out your research project and indicating how a research visit to the Max Planck Institute will contribute to the project, a curriculum vitae and a list of publications. In the case of graduate students, the support of the supervisor is necessary.
