Academic Exchange with the Law Faculty, University of Seville

You are invited to apply to the academic exchange programme between the Institute of European and Comparative Law, on behalf of the Law Faculty, and the Law Faculty of the University of Seville. The exchange is open to Faculty members and doctoral research students of the Oxford Law Faculty who wish to pursue research in Seville. Under the agreement, Oxford may send to Seville two eligible people for up to three months each. Seville will provide accommodation, free of charge, reasonable travel expenses, and library access. There will be no teaching or other formal obligations, although visitors might be asked to give a paper on their ongoing research. Knowledge of the Spanish language is an asset but is not required. In return, one Faculty member or doctoral research student of the Seville Faculty per year will stay at the Oxford Institute. The exchange programme is co-ordinated by Fernando Llano Alonso (Seville) and Matthew Dyson (Oxford).

The timing of the visit is flexible, and will be agreed for each visitor with the co-ordinator in Seville. However, it is not advisable to visit across the summer (in practice, therefore, it is expected that visits will take place before the end of June 2025).

Faculty members and graduate research students who wish to go to Seville during the **academic year 2024-25** should submit their application via this <u>form</u> by 12 noon Friday of Week 0 of Hilary term (**17 January 2025**). Applications should include the completed application form, a (short) statement setting out your research project and indicating how a research visit to the University of Seville will contribute to the project, a curriculum vitae and a list of publications.
