

Admissions Report 2021 – Law Faculty

Overall picture

1899 applications were received for approximately 232 undergraduate degrees this year (excluding – senior status applications). There were approximately 8.18 applicants per available place.

(69 Senior status applications, applications are separate from other applications)

703 applicants were invited to interview for Law, equating to 3.03 per place.

238 offers were made: **192** for Jurisprudence and **46** for Law with Law Studies in Europe (LSE); (**2** deferred Jurisprudence offers are excluded from stats)

12 Colleges participated in the Open Offer Scheme, making **12** offers between them. Colleges making Open Offers are:

Law/LSE had 1899 applications, with 703 being shortlisted to interview, and 238 offers being made.

Law/LSE has an application to interview success rate of **37.05%**, an interview to offer success rate of **34.23%**, with an application to offer success rate of **12.68%**

Senior Status (not included in stats)

69 Senior status applications were received. **15** were interviewed, **8** were made an offer. Senior status candidates had an application to offer rate of **21.05%** and an interview to offer success rate of **53.3%**.
